Community Groups (Dave Kush)

- "Caring for One Another" book study this summer
- 4 community groups launched this fall!
- Blessings of community groups:
 - o Broken people move towards one another
 - People are praying for and caring for one another (physical and spiritual needs are being met)
 - Gospel-centered, grace-saturated community
 - o Ephesians 4:16
- 65% of our members are currently involved in community groups
- Groups are focusing on adopting older folks who are not able to make it on Wednesday nights
- Conflicts naturally happen which give us the opportunity to grow in grace alongside one another

- 92.62% portion of the year has passed
- Categories
 - Missions (more than a quarter of our budget)
 - o Personnel
 - Programs (ministries)

 - Facilities (shared among 4 churches)
- Renovations and big projects are separate from normal budget
- The church has a checkings, savings, and stock account (3 accounts)
 - Stock gets immediately sold and invested in a money market account
- Estimated year end giving total \$273, 142
- Ways to give:
 - Cash (in envelope) in boxes at the back of the sanctuary
 - o Check
 - Zelle banking app
 - Church Center app
- Encourage not to put giving on "automatic" setting but to use giving as an intentional opportunity to worship

 - Goal for 2025 is 50% support

- Some funds will be freed up as a result of James Gomez retiring

- West Side Theology (summer ministry)
- Conferences
 - To keep growing as a pastor and keep getting equipped
 - New Mexico preaching workshop
 - Model from 1 Timothy 4:15 "Let the people see there has been progress"

Facilities

- The church owns the house next door (Miguel Robies has lived there for 18 years in exchange for maintenance and janitorial services) but he will be moving in 2025
- Janitorial services and costs will change

• Giving Statistics

- o 55 households represented in membership
- o 43 households currently give



- o 12 households do not currently give
- o 5 households give 40% of the budget
- Grace-giving is part of being part of the church!

2025 Proposed Budget (Will Sutton)

- Hope to increase funding for Luke Bylsma and Jared Jenkins
- 15% increase in insurance costs
- Two planned renovations/repairs
- Total proposed budget for 2025 is \$275,788 (Estimated offering for 2024 is \$273, 142)
