Finances (Will Sutton)

- Official financial report linked below

- 91.51% of the year has passed
- 91.63% of the budget has been used
- Total in various accounts: \$135,517
- General fund: \$96,271
- Proposed budget
 - Prepared by pastors, deacons, ministry leaders and financial team
 - Increase of \$33,313.96 - increase in personnel and facilities
 - 2025 - 50% funding for Luke, 2026 - 75% funding for Luke
 - Terminating janitorial service with Miguel Robles, increase to be able to pay for janitorial service and lawn care
 - Projected total by end of 2025: \$302,074
 - Budget for 2026: \$309,102 - 2.33% increase

Membership (Luke Bylsma)

 - 2026 budget

- Transfer parking lot funds to major repairs and replacement account - use for renovation or parking lot care down the road (\$15,000)
- Gift of \$10,000 to Frontline Missions International - establish training center in Batan, Indonesia
